DETAIL ITINERARY:

DAY 11: DUBAI

Upon arrival in Dubai, you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel where you will be able to store your luggage. This morning enjoy a half-day sightseeing tour of the cosmopolitan city of Dubai. Even with all its modern buildings Dubai has maintained its Islamic architecture through such monuments as the Jumeirah Mosque. You will have a chance to make various photo stops as the still of the moment guides you towards the oldest part of the city, Batakia. Batakia remains nestled within the bustling city where one can admire the serenity of the old wind-tower houses built by wealthy merchants at the beginning of the century. "Al Fahidi Fort" nearly 200 years old houses the Dubai museum and reveals the history of this city. Walk through the vibrant colors of the textile market to the 'abra' station. Then drift across the creek in 'water-taxis' to feel the warmth of the city. On the other side we proceed across the busy alleys where the aroma of the 'spice souk' filters through the air to the dazzling glitter of the famous Gold Souk to round off the tour. Optional: Evening Sundowner Desert Safari –100 CAD per person:

Late this afternoon you will be picked up and go on a dune drive at the Dubai Desert Conservation Reserve. The mysterious desert beckons you for a magical evening out – an adventure you'll never

forget. Leaving behind the bustle of the city your safari guide will transport you for a thrilling journey over rolling dunes deep into the heart of the desert. From the crest of a high dune, watch the sun cast its orange glow over the vast expanse of rippling sand all round you as it sets. Like a shimmering mirage in the distance you will see the flickering lights of your camp where a traditional Arabian welcome awaits you. The encampment conjures up images of the Arabian nights. Relax on comfortable low cushions in Bedu tents and quench your thirst, have your hands painted with intricate henna designs or just enjoy the aromatic shisha. A feast of grilled meats, fresh salads and delectable Arab sweets will be served and under a galaxy of stars, you will be entertained by the bewitching belly dancer swaying to the haunting strains of Arabian music. You won't want this enchanting evening to end.

DAY 12: DUBAI

Enjoy the day at leisure. Perhaps opt to take part in an exciting optional activity.

Optional: Full Day Abu Dhabi 115 CAD per person (on SIC Basis on Sat, Tue and Wed only)

Abu Dhabi is the largest of the seven emirates; the city has been described by CNN as the richest city in the world. It features large gardens, parks and green boulevards lining the streets and roads with a variety of sophisticated high-rise buildings. Visit the magnificent Sheikh Zayed Mosque and Yas Island, the site of the Yas Marina Circuit and Ferrari World. This afternoon after lunch enjoy time to shop at the famous Marina Mall before a photo stop at the iconic Emirates Palace Hotel and a visit to Manarat Al Saadiyat.

**Dress code for the Mosque - If one does not follow this dress code one will be denied access

Women: longs trousers/ skirt, long sleeves& a head scarf; loose fitting and not see through.

Men: full length trousers and a minimum of a mid-sleeve length shirt.

This morning you will be transferred back Dubai International Airport for your flight home.
